The Old Sacramento *Guideline for Signs* preserves and improves the historic ambience of the Old Sacramento Historic District as a place to live and work and makes Old Sacramento an attraction for visitors who come to shop, dine, and play. The City of Sacramento's History and Archives Division is responsible for assisting merchants with sign regulations and ensuring compliance with the Old Sacramento sign design guidelines.

All permitted signs in Old Sacramento must resemble signs that would have been present in town during the Gold Rush era. The *Guideline for Signs* manual describes the types of signs and sign installation methods that are permitted in Old Sacramento and provides illustrations and advice on designing signs that enhance the historic character of Old Sacramento. Exterior signs must follow the design guidelines – including sign shape, scale, materials, lettering style, colors, message, and visual balance – to produce signs representative of the Gold Rush era from 1849 to 1875.
